



Accessibility Statement for;

Cracoe and Rylstone VC Church of England Primary School

Access to the school site

On Foot

The school is approached by a footpath on the opposite side of a narrow road from the village of Cracoe.

By motorised vehicles

The Village Hall car park has been made available for our use at the beginning and end of the school day. The surface is made of 'chipped' pebbled stone.

There are no designated disabled car parking spaces.

Access to the school from the car park is via a small 'gap' style in a dry stone wall at the bottom of the playground or through a single gate accessed up a broad steep vehicle access drive adjacent to the school boundary.

School site

The site is positioned on a hill.

There are both a slope and steps onto the playground.

The school building can be accessed by a slope and accessed through classroom 1.

Both of the downstairs teaching rooms are accessible by wheel chair.

The intervention/SEN area is upstairs on a mezzanine floor along with the library.

The staffroom, Head teacher's office and adult toilets are upstairs.

There are no soft 'withdrawal' rooms or spaces.

There is a disabled toilet.
