News From Class 2

We are nearly at the end of term and Easter is approaching quickly. This week the children have been completing their end of term assessments in Maths and English. The children all completed them to their best of their abilities and have continued to make great progress in their learning - Well Done Class 2! In between our assessments, the children have been working on area and perimeter in year 4 and 5, while the year 6 children have been continuing with their learning in algebra in maths. In English, we have begun to look at some of the stories from "The tales of 1001 nights" where they have been looking closely at the language that has been used from other cultures and the origins of words. On Monday in science the children completed their experiment on paper strength and were able to reflect on the experiment in their conclusion. This weeks art focus was inspired to our visit to Salts Mills: the children have produced a fantastic pastel picture of Burnsall school in the style of David Hockney. You might just see some of them at next Tuesday's art exhibition!

Class 2—Tag Rugby (Fridays)

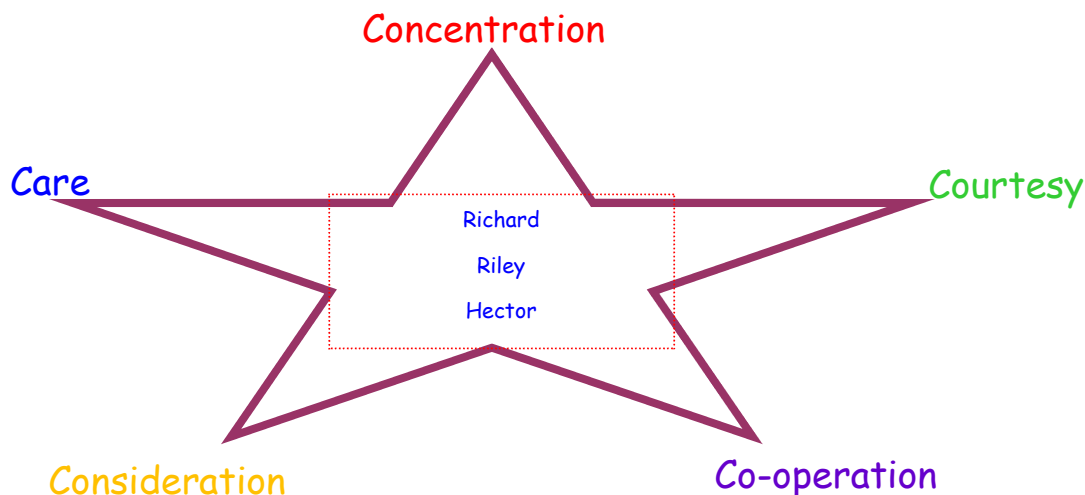

News From Class 1

Just one more week to go! Where has this term gone? The children have been busy this week finishing off lots of things to tie up our topic work and also our non fiction writing. They have used their ICT skills to find pictures of penguins to add to the information pages they have been writing. They added captions to each picture to complete their work. We have been busy observing the signs of Spring which are finally appearing and used this to help us write poems for our new spring board. In maths Mrs Sandoe has continued to work on telling the time whilst I have looked at multiplication arrays with Year 2 and more and less with Year 1. Reception are continuing to investigate numbers to 10. To complete our Topic work we have looked at Ernest Shackleton and his explorations of Antarctica and linked this to the art work of Frances Hatch by creating outlines of Antarctica using classroom objects.

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
