## Message from Class one

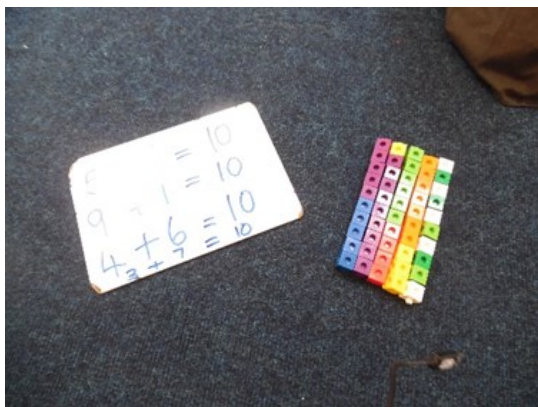
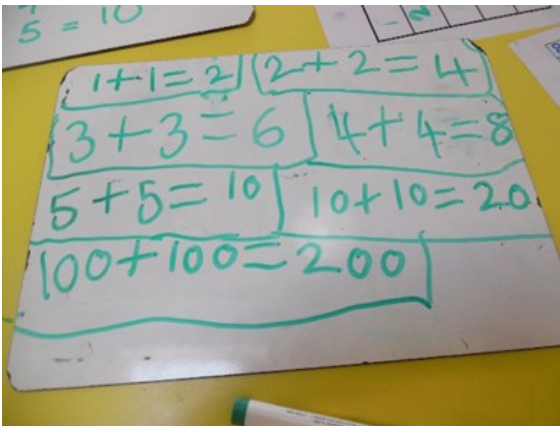
This week has been a strange week! We have started with toast every morning and had some very dirty faces even before 9 o'clock!
