Thank you to everyone who completed the recent survey/questionnaire about Wrap-around Care across the Federation. Your responses have been very helpful in our work to be able to give you the best possible before and after-school provision. We have analysed your responses and they have confirmed, as we expected, that there is a need for further Wrap-around Care to be developed as soon as is practicably possible across the Federation. In September, our existing provision (e.g. Breakfast Clubs, Woosh Club, Sports Clubs) will continue as at present. We are also considering all the options for new additional provision, and we expect to give you news about these as early as possible in the Autumn term. In the short time-frames available, however, it is unlikely that we will be able to put anything new in place for the start of term in September. Work, planning and discussions are ongoing, and we hope to be able to communicate progress with you early in the new academic year.

And finally ... as we look forward to next week and the different leavers' events that will be happening, we would like to wish our Year 6 children a very happy final week of primary school. You have been a real credit to each of your schools in the time you have been there. Thank you for all you have contributed in that time!

Class 1—PE Kit


