News From Class 2

This week in English, the children have been working on a variety of skills that they would need if they were a newspaper reporter. On Wednesday, they had a go at writing direct and reported speech, thinking carefully how Henry (the character in our class read) might have answered the questions. Yesterday afternoon, the children wrote some wonderful poignant war poems based on Henry's experiences that they have been reading about in the story.

On Monday afternoon the class 1 and 2 came together for a mass poppy making session. Using plastic bottles, the children cooperated with each other to carefully cut the bottles into poppy shapes and then painted them. You can now find our simple - but extremely effective - poppies on display outside school.



News From Class 1

I can hardly believe how quickly this half term is passing! The children have been working incredibly hard this week and we will all be ready for a break soon. Mrs Sandoe has done lots of work on number 3 with Reception this week and the children enjoyed basing this work on the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears. They had lots of fun finding 3 of everything for the Bear's cottage and even built three garages. Year 1 have been busy ordering numbers to 20 with some of them even managing to order numbers to 100. Year 2 have been busy looking at 1 more, 1 less and 10 more, 10 less than numbers to 100. They have also been busy looking at the place value of digits in numbers to 100. I have done some more work on 3d shapes and all of the children have been trying to identify shapes from clues about their special features. In literacy we have finished our work on Jack and the Beanstalk and the children have written lovely stories re-telling the tale. Year 2 have been busy adding inverted commas and adjectives to their work whilst Year 1 have looked at making sure they have full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. We have all had fun looking at food from different countries. The children used maps to find where things were coming from and we looked at food which was available when our Great Grandparents, Grandparents and Parents were young.
